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## PRE-SURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Take all daily medications as prescribed by your physician (if any) unless otherwise indicated.

Example: high blood pressure medication or insulin should be taken as directed.

- 2. Take all medications we prescribed as indicated. This may include:
  - a. antibiotic
  - b. anti-inflammatory
  - c. sedative/anti-anxiety
  - d. other
- 3. If a sedative or anti-anxiety is taken prior to appointment, patients must be escorted to and from the office by a friend or family member. If non-compliant we will notify appropriate authorities. Please understand this protocol is for the safety of everyone.
- 4. Do not take Aspirin (Naporsyn, Anaprox, Ascriptin, Feldene) 7 days prior to surgery <u>UNLESS</u> prescribed by your physician for cardiovascular disease, please inform our staff of your dosage. Acetaminophen is permitted.
- 5. If you should become ill the week preceding surgery, please advise the office of your situation 48 hours prior to the appointment.
- 6. Please refrain from using facial cosmetics, especially lipstick.
- 7. Comfortable, loose clothing is advisable, with short sleeves or loose fitting sleeves that can be rolled up to take blood pressure and/or blood draw.
- 8. Please limit yourself with regard to social and business appointments the day of periodontal surgery. Excessive talking or movement of facial muscles may aggravate the surgical site.
- 9. On the day of surgery please eat a normal breakfast and lunch unless otherwise indicated.
- 10. Please avoid caffeine and tobacco prior to your scheduled treatment.
- 11. If treatment involves removal of tooth and/or teeth, please contact your general dentist prior to surgical appointment for possible temporary tooth and/or teeth replacement.
